 - Anne Fitzpatrick

- Had Jenn go to her mother's township (Lansdowne) to discuss placing AED at park, Now doing 10 AEDs and will support funding for training of AEDs
- Funding of AEDs through Simon's heart
- Great way to establish precedent with other Twps
- Simon's Heart will have 20% additional to cover overhead
- Would not charge a fee for one-off, only for larger placements
- Girl Scout troupe in DE wants large placement
- Donations 30% down from same time last year
- AED dollars are not paying for overhead not funded
- Identify Corp partners that we could target, new relationships and help with donations
 - All hands on deck
 - Call to Action tap our networks for potential introductions to Jenn
 - Jenn is asking for help
- Soiree invites do not really identify "Who we are"
- Sending out an impact report to all Life Time Donors who have given \$5k+
- Looking for someone in the host role this year to replace the Kyle's
- Nancy asked Jenn to provide a list of strategic donors to the Board

 - Darren are we appropriately adjusting down this year since we had a number of one-time donations last year. Jenn responded that she did adjust down. Working with

forecasting team to determine if further adjustment is required

 - Jenn does not want our expenses to go over what we're actually capable of raising

 - Could be major \$ however learning that we cannot brand/sponsor with the Jukebox. Can use social media however makes it hard to get a sponsor.
- EITC legitimate educational component that should assist with our application for the credit. 2024 should be the year.
- Darren Oppty to use big sporting events to brag and find corporate sponsors
 - Highlighted Munich Re Munich covers our costs
 - Insurance Co type of events
 - We need intros to companies that sponsor conferences
- Jenn We are dialing for dollars right now.
